Please respect other visitors enjoying the museum. Personal-use photography is permitted in the museum's permanent collection, in our Gift Shop, and on the Museum grounds. However, we cannot permit photographs of: (i) items on loan to us (i.e. not part of the Museum's permanent collection), and (ii) other Museum visitors or staff taken without their permission.

You are welcome to use handheld cameras, cell phones and tablets with the flash turned off. Please do not use tripods, lights or selfie sticks.

Posting images on personal social media websites is allowed, as long as the images are not sold or used for profit. Credit should be given to the Historical Glass Museum in Redlands, California, with reference to our website at www.historicalglassmuseum.com. We would also appreciate receiving copies of your photographs to use on our website or in our newsletter. If photos taken and sent to us are used for these purposes, we will gladly give credit to the photographer, at their request.

Members of the media and commercial photographers should contact us to schedule an appointment in advance.
